Why not use DigiBoosterPro its Mixer to save your DBM's to WAV/AIFF? If DBP works under emulation then you can do it on your pc instead of your Amiga. I guess that gives the best result.

I'm not sure but there exists no good DBM player on other systems.

There is DigiRoller (play/convert DBM to WAVE/AIFF) for OS3, OS4 and MorphOS.

Maybe there is a proper way to convert DBM to XM on windows/linux. In assumption good XM to WAVE converter exists.
